BIOL 371 (3) Flora of British Columbia

Course Description:

Flora of BC, plant identification, and biogeoclimatic zones. Two-week (10-day) course; daily field exercises; equivalent of three lecture hours and three lab hours each day. Offered during spring following final exam period. Students must arrange their own transportation to and from field locations.

Prerequisite: One of BIOL 116, BIOL 117, BIOL 125, BIOL 203, BIOL 210, BIOL 250 and successful completion of 48 academic credits.
